Residential Remodel Submittal Requirements

(CBA Cases - No added square footage; alterations, only)

Document Submittal List:

The below list of submittal items are **needed** to complete your project plan review. A thorough and <u>accurate</u> plan check cannot be performed without a complete submittal package. Lack of required items will result in a delay of your permit issuance. The plan should clearly delineate between all existing and new construction. **As-built submittal and Violations shall be proposed and drawn as NEW construction and <u>not labeled as existing</u>.**

A. **Drawings** Size: Minimum 11" x 17" (18" x 24" preferred for new dwellings) to 24" x 36". All sheets must be drawn to scale and fully dimensioned. Plans shall be clear and legible: non-legible plans will not be accepted.

Submit drawings and supporting documents to online portal in pdf format.

Drawings to Consist of:

1. General Information Show site address, designer, scope of work and applicable codes

2. Plot/Site Plan Show dimension to front, rear, side streets, and to proposed structure,

show location(s) of any and all other structures on the parcel

3. T-24 Sheets Energy compliance documents

4. Architectural Plan Floor plan, roof plans, elevations, sections, other details and uses of all rooms

5. Structural Plan (**if applicable**) Foundation plan, floor & roof framing plans, truss calculation sheets and

structural details. Show size, spacing, species and grade of all framing members. Identify location and lengths of braced wall panels and detail of anchorage

B. Calculations (if required)

1. Structural Calculations Provide stamped and signed set by CA design professional (including lateral

design) when design is not in conformance with conventional light-frame

construction, or as required by the Building Official

2. Manufactured Truss Calcs Provide stamped and signed set by CA engineer, to include the layout. Provide

truss acceptance letter sealed by the licensed design professional

C. Other Documents (if required)

1. Soils Report Provide when required

Plan review and zone check fees must be paid upon submittal of plans.

Note: If 50% or more of the linear foot of walls are removed, or more than 50% of the square footage of the building is altered, the project, existing and new, shall be considered as new construction, the building will be invoiced as a new building and the entire building will be required to comply with all currently adopted codes.

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
